Construction Employment

There are good opportunities in the building and construction industry for skilled workers in many regional locations either as employees or as self-employed contractors.

Licensing

You should be aware that some occupations have specific licensing/registration/English language requirements in order for you to be employed. This may be a separate process from the Skills Assessment you will or have undertaken for migration and visa purposes and often requirements for registration and licensing are more stringent.

For instance, an overseas teacher needs to obtain a positive Skills Assessment from the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL) in order to obtain a general skilled migration visa. However, you need to satisfy the registration requirements with the Teachers' Registration Board of South Australia to be able to work as a teacher in South Australia.

You should investigate these thoroughly to ensure that, if there is specific licensing and registration requirements for your occupation, you are able to meet these requirements before you commence your migration process.

Occupational Licences may be required by individuals who perform certain work where safety is an issue or where certain earthmoving mobile equipment is used. Information about occupational licences can be obtained from Workplace Services (www.ocba.sa.gov.au/licensing).

In addition, people working as contractors, electricians and plumbers are required to possess a contractor's licence. Information about contractor licences can be obtained from the Office of Consumer and Business Affairs at www.ocba.sa.gov.au
